### Time commitment & Requirements:

- The HST must be prepared to travel up to 10 days before the Games opening and leave up to 2 days after the Games closing.
- Attendance to orientation meetings and seminars is mandatory dates and format to be announced subsequently.
- All candidates may be subject to a screening process, including a police records check, prior to the confirmation of their selection.
- Candidates will be required to sign a Team Agreement.

## **Application process:**

The applications are managed by the Expert Groups. The Chief Medical Officer/Chief Doctor and the Chief Therapist will be involved in the selection of the medical support team. Final selections are expected to be













announced between December 2020 and April 2021. Therapists can now apply online through the Canadian Application Portal at <u>apply-coc.smapply.io</u> until November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Physicians must follow CASEM's applications process and deadline.

## **Guidelines for selecting the HST:**

- Final number of practitioners selected on the team is determined following a review of the Sports HST allocations. Note: For the Olympic & Paralympic games, a major portion of the HST will be selected through an NSO application / nomination process independent from this procedure.
- Although previous games experience is an asset for most Games, medical staff selection will take a
  balanced approach in the view of developing games volunteers. Multiple Games experiences will not
  guarantee selection.
- For the Winter Olympic & Paralympic Games, candidates <u>must</u> have prior Major Multi-Sport Games experience.
- For the Commonwealth Games, candidates must have prior Multi-Sport Games experience.
- While Major Games Canada and its partners will take into consideration the rankings of applicants by their Expert Groups, the HST selections will be made based on:
  - 1. The needs and requirements of the different sports, and the overall HST
  - 2. Appropriate balance of skill sets
  - 3. Equity & diversity
  - 4. Availability of health care services to the Canadian delegation in both official languages
  - 5. Team Dynamics
  - 6. The limited number of accreditation available.

### **Additional Information:**

- Please note that given the actual global circumstances of the COVID-19 pandemic, the selection for the Games could eventually be suspended, delayed or cancelled. In the situation where the Games themselves would have to be cancelled, the selected professionals would not be given priority in future selections as compensation.
- Expenses for participation as a member of the team will be covered by the franchise holders.
- Most positions are voluntary; there is no salary or honorarium.
- Complete job descriptions for each role will be provided before the Games. General descriptions of role
  and responsibilities can be found through this <u>link</u>. Some franchise holders may have more specific role
  descriptions for their Games which will be shared with the selected candidates.
