



## **COVID-19 Operational Procedure for In-Person Education**

For the purpose of this Procedure, the term “attendees” refers to students, educators and assistants.

### **Procedure:**

- Cross-border travel restrictions and the ability to limit viral contamination, courses and examinations will be held in the provinces in which attendees reside.
- Number of attendees will be determined based on Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) and the applicable Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health recommendations and may vary from province to province.
- Attendees shall be respective of current applicable provincial social distancing requirements.
- Plinths must be arranged such that they meet all Provincial Health Authority guidelines.
- All attendees must complete the screening documentation in advance of in-person instructional days and advised that they are not permitted to attend if they are experiencing symptoms.
- All attendees will complete screening on entry daily and any attendee screening positive will be advised they cannot attend and directed to follow the Isolation Protocol.
- Cleaning of the training facility, all equipment and tools shall be conducted in accordance with the Infection Control Protocol.
- The use of Personal Protective Equipment is required in accordance with the Infection Control Protocol.
